1. Ski - Basic

Skis and Boots: Dynastar Agyl skis
Volkl R1 and K2-2 skis
Salomon rear entry and Nordica front entry boots

Description:

Best for beginners and those who have completed 1 or 2 ski trips and are making "skidded" turns. Basic skis are usually chosen by those who identify their skier type as Cautious and for those who are budget conscious.



2. Ski - Sport

Skis and Boots: Dynastar Supra skis
Salomon Verse front-entry boot (soft shell, speed lacing system)
Nordica EZ Move front-entry boot

Description:

Sport skis are best for a broad range of recreational skiers who are working to improve their carving skills. Sport skis are usually chosen by those who identify their skier type as Moderate.



3. Ski - Performance

Skis and Boots: A wide variety of High performance skis
Salomon Performa skis
Nordica 5.2 & GTS front-entry boot (hard shell)

Description:

Best for accomplished carvers who plan to ski the whole mountain on varying terrain and conditions. Performance skis are usually chosen by those who identify their skier type as Aggressive.



4. Ski - Junior

Skis and Boots: Dynastar Team Speed & 4X4 skis
Salomon, Nordica and Lange front and rear-entry boots

Description:

Generally, Junior skis are for those 12 and under, However, some adult-sized, pre-teens may perform better in an adult package, especially if they are experienced skiers.



1. Snowboard - Basic

Boards and Boots: Burton LTR (Learn to Ride) Board
Burton Double Lace snowboard boots

Description:

The Burton LTR snowboard is best for newer riders and can be used as part of the National Burton Learn to Ride lesson program.

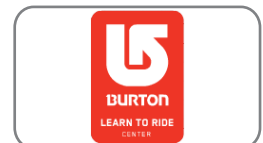


2. Snowboard - Sport

Boards and Boots: Burton Cruzer & Dominant snowboards
Burton Double Lace snowboard boots

Description:

The Burton Sport snowboards are best for the more advanced snowboarder who is linking turns.



3. Snowboard - Junior

Boards and Boots: Burton Junior LTR
Burton Double Lace snowboard boots and single lace boots
in the smaller sizes.

Description:

Junior snowboards are for the younger rider, 12 and under.
